Chasing the Gas: The Arecibo Galaxy Environment Survey

Abstract:

The Arecibo Galaxy Environment Survey (AGES) is carrying out deep neutral hydrogen observations of different environments in the local universe. I will discuss recent results, including observations of the neutral hydrogen environment of isolated galaxies and of the population of gas clouds around M33. I will also introduce our planned Widefield Arecibo Virgo Extragalactic Survey (WAVES), which will extend AGES-depth coverage to most of the Virgo cluster. This is expected, based on AGES results on a part of the cluster, to uncover numerous neutral hydrogen clouds that lie below the column-density threshold of shallower surveys such as ALFALFA.
