

AUTHOR GUIDELINES FOR RFI 2016 ABSTRACTS

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Abstracts must be text-only and consist of at least 250 words and be up to one page long, including figures. All abstracts must be written in clear English. Please do not use symbols, special characters, or math in title or abstract body, and do not number pages. An example of illustration is shown in Figure 1.

References should only be given parenthetically, for example: (R. L. Lewis and J. R. Johler, Radio Sci., 2, 75-81, 1976). Acknowledgement of financial support is not deemed appropriate in abstract, but should be indicated in the proceedings paper. The abstract text should appear about 0.5 inch (12 mm) below the title area. Also indicate up to five keywords.

Once the abstract has been prepared using this template, it needs to be saved as a PDF document for submission on the workshop website.

Index Terms — Keyword one, two, three, four, five.
